The 2nd Joint Annual Conference of ZU 'International Conference on Translational Medicine in collaboration with EUSTM (European Society of Translational Medicine) and HEC was an unprecedented event in the history of health science in Pakistan. The conference was held in Ziauddin University from 1-3 February 2016. The theme for this year's event was "From Discovery to Health Care". Amid the backdrop of Translational Medicine, more than 300 delegates from national and international scientific community explored a plethora of natural and scientific resources to meet the growing healthcare needs of the Pakistani population. The tone of the conference was set on the inaugural session with the keynote lecture by Professor Dr. Atta-ur-Rehman ,UNESCO Laurette, who gave a fascinating insight into the recent advances made in medical science. Numerous prominent scientists nationally and globally had accepted the organizers invitations: Professor Dr. Anwarul Hassan Gilani (Chairman: Pakistan Council for Science and Technology, Guest of Honor). Professor Dr. Amir Shazad (President: European Society for Translational Medicine) Professor Dr. Gottfried Kohler (University of Vienna, Austria) Dr. Nessar Ahmed (School of Healthcare Science, Manchester Metropolitan University UK). Professor Dr. Umar Daraz Khan (Aesthetic Plastic Surgeon, UK) Professor Dr. Khalid Rehman

(School of Pharmacy and Biomolecular Sciences, Liverpool John Moores University). Professor Dr. Bachher (Speech and Language pathologist, Tata Memorial Hospital, Mumbai India). Dr. Zehra Fadoo (Agha Khan University). Dr. Kulsoom Ghais (Agha Khan University). Dr. Aneela Javed (NUST Islamabad). Dr. Nikhat Ahmed Siddiqui, Dr. Mervyn Hosien and Dr. Rubina Hussain of Ziauddin University also presented their research. The workshop provided a platform of a focused group for promoting new ideas and communications in genomics and helped clinicians to understand the role in health and disease. ZIAUDDIN UNIVERSITY HOLDS 3RD INTERNATIONAL GYNAECOLOGY SYMPOSIUM









In order to spread awareness about gynaecology, Ziauddin University organised a full day international symposium on gynaecology, in collaboration with Royal College of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists (RCOG) and Department of Continuing Professional Education (ZU). The objective of the symposium was to enlighten local health providers and broaden their horizon on the rapidly changing advances in modern treatment.

"The severity of Ovarian Cancer in Pakistan is of prime importance as around 13.6 per cent of females have been suffering from this cancer in the country and around 70 percent are diagnosed at advanced stages only". Health experts revealed this in a session of international awareness symposium on gynaecology.

Dr. Noor Jehan Samad, the chief guest at the symposium, welcomed the participation of young doctors and said it is the time to synergize the efforts of medical fraternity, policy makers, government and media. "Awareness can play a very significant role in dealing with the challenge of Ovarian Cancer in Pakistan. International awareness symposium on Gynaecology organized by Ziauddin University will stimulate other institutions to follow the footprint to address the growing challenge," she added.

She emphasized on proper Antenatal Clinics and preventive obstetrics and early detection of Diabetes mellitus. "Diagnostic of ovarian cancer at early stages will cut down the medical burden and suffering of the patients and family," she added.

Prof. Rubina Hussain Head of Department, Gynaecology Ziauddin Hospital said we should keep pace up with the changes and development in women care. Pakistan should follow footprint of international health care system and we must adapt ourselves according to it. Our objective must be to ensure better treatment for the patient. We have a complete research department in Ziauddin University and Hospital to address this issue and we also publish research papers in medical journal for the same purpose.

Prof. Dr. Tariq Siddiqui, Professor and Director Ziauddin Cancer Hospital, talked about "After surgery (and Before)" and said the treatment of malignant disease like other disciplines in medicine is highly data dependent and data synthesis leads to therapeutic decisions.

He also spoke about the problems in assessing patients after surgery and a positive cancer report. "The reports that patients bring are from all over the place and standard are lacking generally except in the large referral hospitals and radiology testing in the country is an industry with no controls and cost determines where patients go for CT scans, MRI tests, etc.," he said adding that the few CT films which are available often have no relevance to the lesions described discussion of the test. "Giving awareness to patients in this regard is also important as they often go for cheaper tests but end up spending more when the tests are not upto the quality standards," he added.

Dr. Tasneem Aslam Tariq, Dr. Adnan Zuberi, Dr. Qurat-ul-Ain Badar, Ms. Fauzia Pesnani, Ms. Amina Mujib Khan also spoke on the occasion. They stated that ovarian cancer is a common and fatal gynecological malignancy with high morbidity and mortality. In Pakistan ovarian cancer is the second most common cancer among women accounting 13.6% female malignancy.

They said long term survival chances are less than 30 per cent at advance stages and symptoms are non-specific. "Tumor markers are non-specific and CA-125 (Cancer Antigen -125) is not the marker for ovarian cancer only and it may be raised in other conditions as well," they added.
